## NSPCC

On Tuesday 21<sup>st</sup> May the NSPCC will be visiting school to deliver The NSPCC Speak Out, Stay Safe Programme. An assembly will be given separately to both KS1 and KS2 with a follow-up workshop to years 5 and 6. Each assembly will delivered in a sensitive and age appropriate manner.

The objectives of the programme are:

- To ensure primary School aged children have an understanding of abuse in all its forms, including bullying, and an ability to recognise the signs of abuse.
- To ensure primary School aged children know how to protect themselves from all forms of abuse.
- To make them aware of how to get help and sources of help including Childline.
